

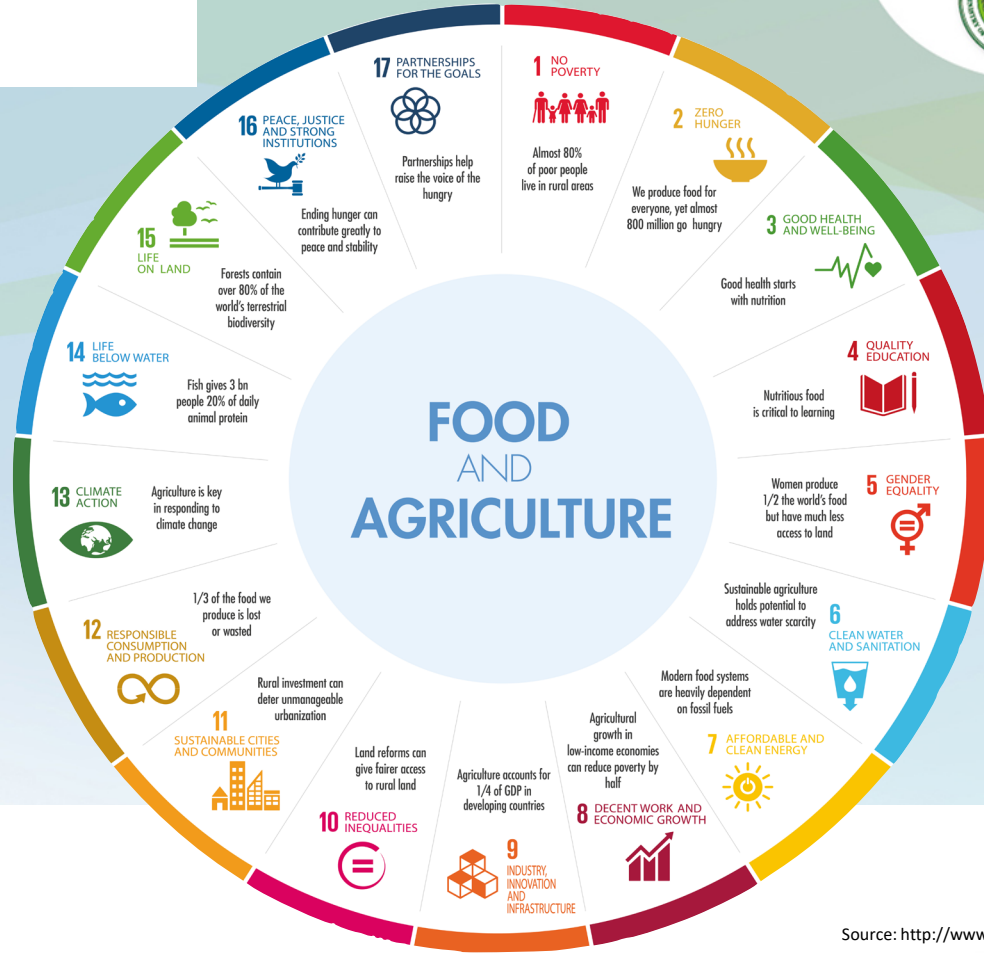

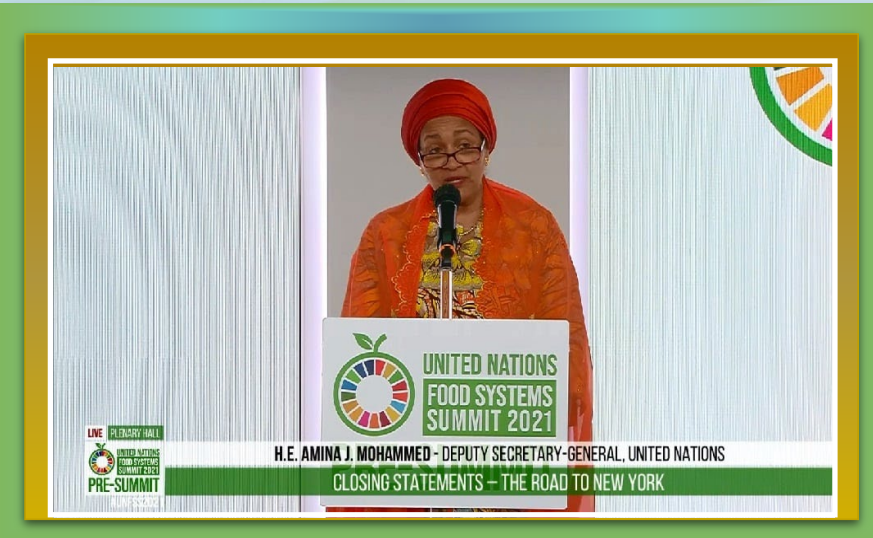


Actions Before the Summit
